


The rhytms of BRAZIL and ARGENTINA and the beauty of IGUAZU FALLS! 22 - 31 October 2025





Day 1 (22 Oct) <u>Arrival in Sao Paulo (GRU airport)</u> after landing and collecting your luggage, our Tour Manager will be waiting at the airport with a Blue Amber Travel sign - we start our journey! Short city tour during which we will see the Sé Cathedral - a neo-Gothic temple and icon of São Paulo, the Municipal Theater in the Belle Époque style, Ibirapuera Park - the green heart of the city with gardens, museums and a picturesque lake, and Paulista Avenue a modern business and cultural center. Lunch, then transfer to the hotel for overnight stay.





Day 4 (25 Oct) Breakfast. Transfer to explore the energetic Rio de Janeiro. Today we will marvel at the beautiful landscape by taking the cable car ride on Sugarloaf Mountain, soaking in panoramic views of the city, beaches, and Atlantic Ocean. Later we invite you for dinner at a Churrascaria, a Brazilian steakhouse with meat skewers cut directly to your plate, side dishes and salad like buffet style. Enjoy an excellent gastronomic experience! Transfer to the hotel, overnight stay.

Day 5 (26 Oct) Breakfast. We will start our adventure by going to the top of Corcovado Mountain, where we will see the famous Christ the Redeemer monument up close - the symbol of the city and one of the seven new wonders of the world! From here we will admire the breathtaking panoramic view of Rio, which stretches from the mountain peaks to the blue waters of the Atlantic. The next stop - Maracanã district, known worldwide for its iconic stadium. Then Sambódromo, where the famous Carioca carnival takes place every year - a place that will allow us to feel the hot rhythm of Samba. During the tour, we will stop for coffee in one of the oldest cafes in Rio - Confeitaria Colombo. Then board a sailboat for a sunset cruise in Rio's Guanabara Bay, and take in the sights of this spectacular city from the water. Relax and follow the sunset to get amazing photo shots. Return to the hotel. Dinner, overnight stay.











Day 6 (27 Oct) Breakfast. Departure flight to Foz do Iguacu. After landing, drive to the Brazilian side of the Iguazú Falls to discover this wonder of one of the natural seven wonders of the world! A walk through the Iguazú National Park will take us along paths and viewpoints from which you can admire as many as 275 cascades. We will see the water splashing over the rocks with a roar, creating rainbow mists that float in the air. Return to the hotel. Dinner, overnight stay.

Day 7 (28 Oct) Breakfast. Drive to the <u>Argentinian side of the famous Iguazú Falls.</u> Walking along numerous footbridges and paths, we will be able to admire the power of the falling water and the mists of the cascades. We will also reach the largest waterfall - the Devil's Throat, which takes your breath away with its scale. We will be accompanied by exotic butterflies, various birds and coatis. Cross the border to check in at a hotel in Brazil, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 8 (29 Oct) Breakfast. Fly to Buenos Aires. Time for lunch and relax. In the evening, for those willing (**optional at your own cost) <u>Argentinian authentic Tango show in an idyllic atmosphere, accompanied by a traditional menu and excellent Argentine wines. Dinner.</u> Return to the hotel.

Day 9 (30 Oct) Breakfast. Drive to explore Buenos Aires, known as the Paris of South America. We will start the day with a walk through the historic Plaza de Mayo, where we will see the famous Casa Rosada - the seat of the Argentine government, the colonial building El Cabildo and the impressive cathedral. Then we will walk along Avenida 9 de Julio, one of the widest streets in the world, where in its central point stands the majestic Obelisk - the symbol of the city. We will visit the artistic district of La Boca, known for its colorful tin houses and the Boca Juniors club stadium, then go to the modern district of Puerto Madero, where we will admire the elegant Puente de la Mujer bridge. At the end of the tour, we will visit the Recoleta cemetery, the resting place of Eva Perón, the icon of Argentina. Transfer to the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.

Day 10 (31 Oct) Breakfast. On the last day of the trip - Argentine Pampa! Get a taste of life on traditional cattle ranch visit a typical estancia and see Argentina's legendary gauchos. Enjoy folklore show with guitar music and dance, including the famous Tango and gaucho skills demonstration. We will learn about the traditions of everyday life of gauchos who are Argentine cowboys. Then a taste of "asado" - barbecue dinner with prime cut meat and chorizo sausages accompanied with salads and excellent quality wine. End of the trip. Transfer to the airport for departure to the USA From Buenos Aires (EZE airport)
